RE: NATIONAL ACCREDITATION OF TRADE TESTING CENTRES


The National Artisan Development Quality Assurance Committee (NADQAC) has been established to coordinate accreditation across all sectors in order to progressively implement a national non-sector based accreditation process.

The committee agreed that during this transitional period, trade testing centres that have been accredited by a SETA for (a) specific trade(s) may be used by any other SETA without having to audit or accredit that centre again. The decision as it reflects in the NADQAC decision register reads as follows:

If a Centre is accredited for a specific trade by one SETA, that centre can now be used by any other SETA for that specific trade to test at that centre. This transitional rule applies retrospectively. 16/07/2014
