Did you Know that to qualify for NSFAS funding, you should meet the following criteria?

1. You should be a South African citizen planning to study at a public university or TVET college.

2. You must come from a household with a combined household income of not more than **R350 000** per year, **R600 000** per year if you have a disability and **R122 000** per year if you started studying before 2018.

3. Agree to the terms and conditions of the NSFAS grant or bursary awarded.

STEPS ON HOW TO CREATE NAFSAS ACCOUNT



Did you know that to create your MyNSFAS account you need to follow the below steps:

- Step 1:**
www.nsfas.org.za and click on the 'myNSFAS ACCOUNT' tab
- Step 2:**
Click on 'register'
- Step 3:**
Tick on the acceptance option to allow NSFAS to verify and validate the information you provided
- Step 4:**
Type in your ID number as it appears on your ID document
- Step 5:**
Type in your name and surname as they appear on your ID Document
- Step 6:**
Type in your email address and cell phone number
- Step 7:**
Create a username and password
- Step 8:**
Click on 'register'
- Step 9:**
After clicking register, a One Time Pin (OTP) will be sent to the email address and cell phone number you provided
- Step 10:**
Check your cell phone and email for the OTP
- Step 11:**
Type in the OTP in the tab provided and click submit
- Step 12:**
You will then receive another SMS and email confirming that your myNSFAS account has been created. You may now continue with your application.

STEPS ON HOW TO RESET YOUR LOGIN DETAILS

Step 3:

Click on the 'Forgot password' tab

Step 4:

Enter your ID number in the space provided

Submit

Step 7:

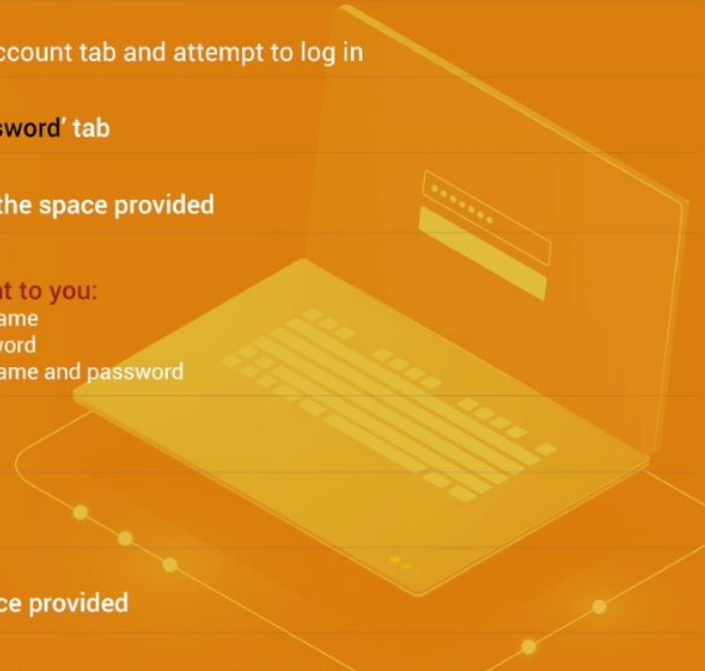
You will receive an OTP
